

Training sessions

The EduStat software is available in four versions to meet specific needs:

- "Items Bank" version
- "Sampling" version
- "Statistics" version
- "Full" version

Regardless of the used version, EduStat includes a set of documents presenting the different data processing options. It is possible to consult them and to acquire the skills allowing an optimal use of the software. Micro Center Pythagore offers the possibility of conducting training sessions tailored to the needs of EduStat users. Given the type of data processing used, it is thus possible to propose a personalized training program.

Training modules are available. Each one allows to explore one option of data processing or the production of statistical compilations. According to the needs expressed by the users of the software, a tailor-made training program can be offered. The following table provides a list of modules that can be part of a training program.

Note # 1: There will be use of available databases; strictly speaking, it would not be necessary to prepare databases adapted to the types of statistical compilation.

Note # 2: There will be available some items banks; Strictly speaking, it would not be necessary to prepare the items banks; another module deals with the preparation of the items banks.

Note # 3: We should have followed module 3 and ideally module 2. We will use databases prepared by Micro Centre Pythagore.

Note # 4: There will be use of available databases; ideally, module 2 should have been followed. Module 3 summarizes the sampling approach; if this module has not been presented, the exercises related to the selection of samples presented in module 3 should be carried out.
